Frequent Q&A

1. When is soccer registration?

Soccer registration for Fall 2023 will run from July 3rd -August 17th, with late registration running from August 8th-11th with an additional charge.

2. What does my registration pay for?

A soccer jersey and a pair of soccer socks, as well as an end of season medal for U8 teams and under are all included in your registration cost.

- 3. What does my player need to wear/bring for soccer practices and games?

 Players need to wear athletic clothing for both practices and games. Players are
 responsible for purchasing their own cleats, shin guards and black shorts for the season. If
 players own a soccer ball, they are welcome to bring it to the Y, but please write the player's
 name on the ball.
- 4. How long is the season?

The Fall 2023 season will begin with practices the week of August 21st. Games will begin on September 16th. Regularly scheduled games should end the weekend before Thanksgiving Break.

5. Where are the games?

U4(Itty Bitty), U6- U10 games will all be played here at the Bell Family YMCA. U12 and Middle School teams will play at the Bell Family YMCA and will also travel to play other teams like Anderson YMCA, Athens YMCA and Brad Akins YMCA (Winder). These games and dates are TBA.

6. Can I request a coach and/or another player to be on my team?

There is a space available on the soccer registration form to request a certain coach and also to request that another player be put on the same team as your child. This is for Itty Bitty and U6 ages ONLY. While we do our best to honor these requests, they are not always guaranteed. The U8, U10, U12 and 15U age groups will be put into a player evaluation, so requests are not accepted.

7. When are practices and games?

Practice days are any weekday and can be scheduled between 5-7pm. Game days can be any day besides Sunday. All schedules depend on number of teams and field availability.

8. Can I request a specific practice day and time?

We do not accept practice day or time requests. Signing up for YMCA soccer is a commitment to getting your child to their assigned day and time for practices and games.

9. What is the refund policy?

To view our refund policy, please see the YMCA Participant Waiver form attached to the registration form.

10. What is the weather policy?

Soccer will be played in rain or shine. If there is thunder or lightning, games will be suspended for 30 minutes from the last lightning/thunder observed. In extreme heat, water breaks will be scheduled during games by the referees.
